Family Intensive Treatment (FIT) Team

1. **Question:** Can the funding be utilized to deliver services both during and after the stated dates in the ITN; Oct. 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016? For example, persons served who are admitted under the program on June 1st will likely require services after June 30th.

Answer: Funding is recurring contingent on appropriation by the Florida Legislature.

2. **Question:** While responding to the questions in the Invitation to Negotiate, we utilize the Rating Sheet to make sure we address all areas. In doing so, we noticed that on page 38 information is being requested and 25 points are being allocated to Section I, a total of 85 points for Section II, 10 points for Sections III, and 10 points for Section IV. This is a total of 130 points. However, on page 9 of the ITN, it states the maximum number of points an applicant can earn is 85 points. Please clarify what we are to include in the application and if the rating scale included in the ITN is going to be used to rate our application.

Answer: Twenty (20) points are being allocated to Response Section I. Per pages 24-25 of the solicitation document, points will be awarded as follows:

Response Section 1: SECTION I: GENERAL APPLICATION SECTION (TOTAL 20 points for SECTION I)

- A. Abstract/Project Summary (5 points)
- B. Table of Contents (no points)
- C. Organization Information (section - 15 points)

Response Section 2: SECTION II: PROGRAM SECTION (TOTAL 85 points for SECTION II)

Response Section 3: SECTION III: BUDGET SECTION – (TOTAL 10 points for SECTION III)

Full agency budget submission is required. This budget should incorporate staffing patterns and program operational costs.

Response Section 4: ATTACHMENTS (10 points for complete Attachments as required in this solicitation)
